The Community Relations Council is an Arm's-Length body of The Executive Office, and a key delivery agent of the Executive's "Together: Building A United Community" (T:BUC) strategy.

CORE FUND

The Core Funding Scheme provided the largest investment with

£1.3m

strategically deployed to 31 groups throughout the Region dedicated to peacebuilding.

NBSGRP

The North Belfast Strategic Good Relations Programme invested

£674k

to 10 organisations to facilitate good relations interventions across all four T:BUC strategy themes.

CR/CD SMALL GRANTS

The Community Relations and Cultural Diversity scheme invested

£173k

to fund 74 projects by community and voluntary groups in local communities.

OVERALL IMPACT

A total overall fund of investment for 2022/23 of

£2.3m

was awarded to groups and projects across all our grant schemes.
